Why do Estonians have electricity plans?

Most Estonians have electricity plans linked to the current spot price, enabling them to respond to hourly price fluctuations and manage their consumption more efficiently. Estonia is an active participant in the European Union's electricity market. This integration is pivotal for the country's energy policy and market dynamics.

Is Estonia part of Nord Pool's open electricity market?

Estonia is part of Nord Pool's open electricity market together with Norway, Sweden, Finland, Denmark, Latvia and Lithuania (see map). In the open electricity market (power exchange), the price of electricity is formed as a result of supply and demand. There is at least one price area in each country, in a larger country there may be several.

What data does Statistics Estonia collect?

To produce energy statistics, Statistics Estonia collects the following data: stocks of energy products, imports and exports. In Estonia, a large share of energy is still produced from non-renewable resources such as oil shale.

Who regulates the energy sector in Estonia?

The Estonian Competition Authority regulates the energy sector and reports to the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Communications. Four main operators are involved in the supply, trading, and logistics of oil: Alexela, Vopak EOS, Scantrans (Ireland) and Eurodek (Denmark).

Why do Estonians use smart meters?

Over 98% of Estonian households are equipped with smart meters, following European Union regulations. These advanced meters provide real-time data on electricity usage, measuring consumption hourly. The widespread adoption of smart meters allows consumers to be more informed about their energy usage.
