Is it safe to store gasoline if a gas pump goes down?

Can you use a gas can to store water?

How do you store a gas pump?

At the pump, aim to fill the gas containers no more than 95 percent full to allow for some expansion. Replace the container cap, making sure it is screwed on tightly. Store the container in a shed or other outbuilding away from the house and out of direct sunlight.
